## Kid's Connection



Three Parables

**Main Point:**

Jesus is the One who seeks and saves the lost.

**Christ Connection:**

The religious leaders complained that Jesus welcomed sinners. Jesus told these parables to teach about God's forgiveness. God sent Jesus so sinners can be forgiven. As Savior, Jesus seeks sinners. He paid the ultimate price – His own life – to save people from sin.

**Family Discussion Starters:**

- \*How many sheep were there in the first parable?
- \*How many did the shepherd lose? What did he do when he found it?
- \*What did the woman do when she lost one of her coins?
- \*When did she celebrate with her friends?
- \*What did the younger son in the third parable do with the money his father gave him?
- \*How did the father greet the younger son when he returned home?
- \*How does Jesus feel about people who don't know Him?
- \*How can we show love to lost people?

**Family Activity:**

- \*Play a game of hide and seek with your family in a local park or in your home. See who can find the "lost" people fastest.
- \*Help your kids look around your home for lost change. See if they can find enough for a candy bar or other treat.

As you do these activities, remind your children of the three parables that Jesus taught they learned about this week.
