Main Point:

Jesus healed ten lepers but only one returned to give thanks.

Christ Connection:

Jesus healed ten lepers. Only one came back, throwing himself at the feet of Jesus. Clearly this man had been healed not only physically but spiritually also. We are also sick with sin and condemned to death. By dying on the cross, Jesus saved us and gave us a greater healing, the forgiveness of our sins.

Family Discussion Starters:

- *What was wrong with the sick men?
- *How many lepers did Jesus heal?
- *How many lepers came back to thank Jesus?
- *Where did the others go?
- *What is something you did not thank Jesus for?
