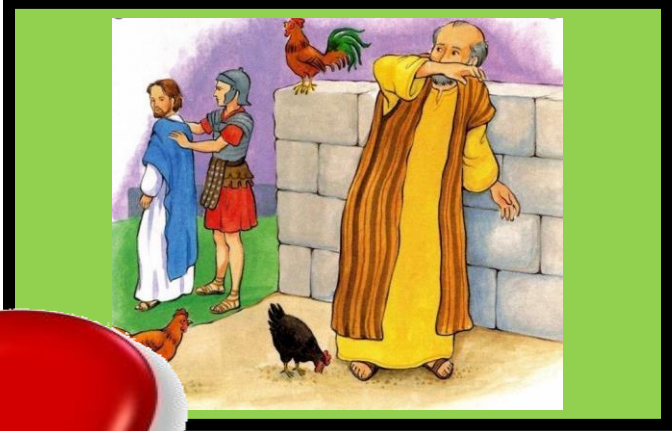

# Kid's Connection



## Peter Denies Jesus

**Main Point:**

Peter denied Jesus three times just like Jesus said he would.

**Christ Connection:**

Peter's confidence was in himself, not in Jesus. Peter was a sinner, but the good news is that Jesus would die on the cross for Peter. He took the punishment Peter deserved for denying Him. Like Peter, we often trust in our own strength, but we need to trust in Jesus. That is important, because, like Peter, we can't win the battle with sin on our own.

**Family Discussion Starters:**

- \*What did Peter say to Jesus when He told him that Peter would deny Him 3 times?
- \*Who recognized Peter?
- \*Where was Peter when the servant girl recognized him?
- \*What happened when Peter said he did not know Jesus for the third time?

**Family Activity:**

Use a beach ball or other large, lightweight ball and ask your child to hide the ball somewhere you cannot see it, but they must keep holding it. The ball should be large enough to make this impossible. As they try, repeatedly say "I can see it". Explain to them that the ball is like our sin, which we can't hide from God. Tell them that just like Peter, we can fall into sin and must depend on Jesus to help us.
